

2016 ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PROGRAMME "CULTURAL JOURNALISM"

The objective of the "Cultural Journalism" programme is to support quality cultural media activities that stimulate public interest in the contemporary art scene, placing particular emphasis on publications that demonstrate the potential of contemporary art to inspire the mind at play, self-reflection and social dialogue. The nature of the programme is determined by ABLV Charitable Foundation's participation in the privately funded initiative that has undertaken to build the Latvian Museum of Contemporary Art (LMCA) in Riga by 2021. Overall, to date, we have supported 9 projects within this programme, investing a total sum of EUR 270 074 and will continue to support the development of this programme in Latvia in future. The report on the results of our work is updated once every quarter.
