





## 2015 ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PROGRAMME "SUPPORT FOR CONTEMPORARY ART EXHIBITIONS"

In order to facilitate the successful fulfilment of the joint initiative supported by the ABLV Charitable Foundation to open the Latvian Museum of Contemporary Art (LMCA) in 2021, the goal of the programme is to generate public interest in contemporary art, not only by challenging people to think, but also by stimulating their appetite for learning, as well as by getting them to look in the mirror, ask themselves questions and swap ideas and experiences. Under the programme, grants are awarded to professional-level exhibitions of national importance that support cutting edge contemporary art in Latvia or provide coverage of research work into contemporary art. Overall, to date, we have supported 79 projects within this programme, investing a total sum of EUR 582 465 and will continue to support the development of this programme in Latvia in future. The report on the results of our work is updated once every quarter.
